Student Village Short Stays

In the heart of student life



IMPORTANT NOTES:

- As of 1 January 2011 the Student Village will be smoke free accommodation and there will be an increase to costs.
- Weekday and weekend arrival and departure times are strictly limited. You should advise your expected time arrival.
Weekdays: 10am - 2pm or 6pm - 10pm. **Weekends:** Between 5pm – 10pm.
- Car parking is limited. Please advise the Student Village office prior to booking your room if you require a car park.

What will it cost?

New rates from 1 January 2011.

Weekly charges are based on Monday to Sunday. Stays of less than one week duration, are charged at the nightly rate.

Up to one week stay

- » \$165 one week, Monday to Sunday OR
- » \$65 per night

1 week plus additional nights (Maximum short stay is four weeks)

- » Monday to Sunday \$165 per week
- » Additional 1– 3 nights \$35 per night
- » Additional 4 – 7 nights, charged at a flat rate of \$165

Car park fee

- » At a flat rate of \$30 per week

Payment Method

Personal: Payments must be paid on arrival (EFTPos is available).

Company: If a company is paying for the accommodation please .email the following at least 3 days prior to your arrival.

What is provided

We have dedicated one house to short stay residents. Therefore, you will share a 9 single bedroom house with only 2-3 full-time students.

You will have a single, fully furnished bedroom with central heating and bed linen. All cooking facilities and utensils, laundry facilities, toilet and showers are located in the house and are included in your rent. Internet access is free of charge and is available in your room if you have your own laptop and network cable. A internet logon can be obtained from your block course administrator.

We have a Residential and Assistant Manager who live onsite who can assist with any urgent matters. In addition your house has a Senior Resident available to help you become familiar with the house and the facilities of the Student Village.

Policies and Procedures

All students residing at the Student Village are expected to be familiar with our [Policies and Procedures](#). Short Stay residents who do not adhere to these policies and procedures will have their residency terminated and will be charged rent up to the date of the termination of residency.

What you need to bring

You will need to provide your own food however there are local bakeries and takeaways within walking distance of the Student Village. The Student

Village also has a van that takes residents to a local supermarket on a weekly basis. Ask for details of this service on arrival.

You will also need to provide your own personal toiletry items e.g. toilet paper, soap, towels etc.

Where are we located?

You will find the Student Village is within easy walking distance to both the North and South Campuses on Alexander Crescent, Otara. Following are driving directions and a map of our location.

Directions From The Motorway

- After 0.1 km, go left onto Entry And Exit 444 East Tamaki Rd
- After 0.1 km, go left onto East Tamaki Rd
- After 0.3 km, go left onto Otaru Rd
- After 0.5 km, go right onto Bairds Rd
- After 0.2 km, go left onto Alexander Cres
- Go Straight to Gate 15, Alexander Crescent on your left hand side
