Where to arrive

Meeting Point

Once you arrive, please proceed to **Building 307 (Mataaho)**  (See Appendix 1) This is your **meeting point** and where you will prepare for firefighting activities.

Gear Requirements

- Cotton overalls and boots will be provided
- You **must wear cotton, natural fibre socks** and underwear
- You **must wear closed, flat shoes with socks**

Not permitted on the fire ground:

- Jandals
- Sandals
- Any open footwear
- Matches, cigarette lighters

! *Anyone wearing prohibited footwear will be refused entry.*



Unitec Parking (See Appendix 1)

- \$1/hour, cap \$3 (Mon–Fri, 8am–4pm, Semesters 1 & 2). Free outside these times and during semester breaks.
- Pay by pay-by-plate machines, Parkeasy, QR code on signs, or ParKiwi app.
- Visitor parking is for external visitors only (not staff/students).

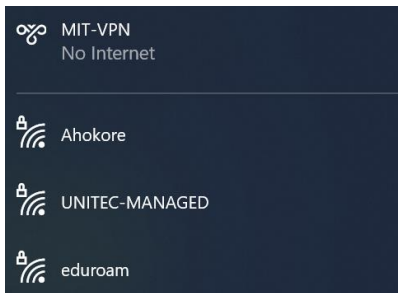

 - **EAP Method:** Leave as default (PEAP)
 - **Phase 2 authentication:** Leave as default (None or MSCHAPV2)
 - **CA Certificate:** Select “Don’t validate”
 - **User Certificate:** Leave as unspecified
 - **Identity:** Enter your MIT email address username@manukau.ac.nz
 - **Anonymous identity:** (Leave Blank)
 - **Password:** Enter your MIT password
2. Tap Connect
3. When connected to the eduroam, your network will show as “connected”

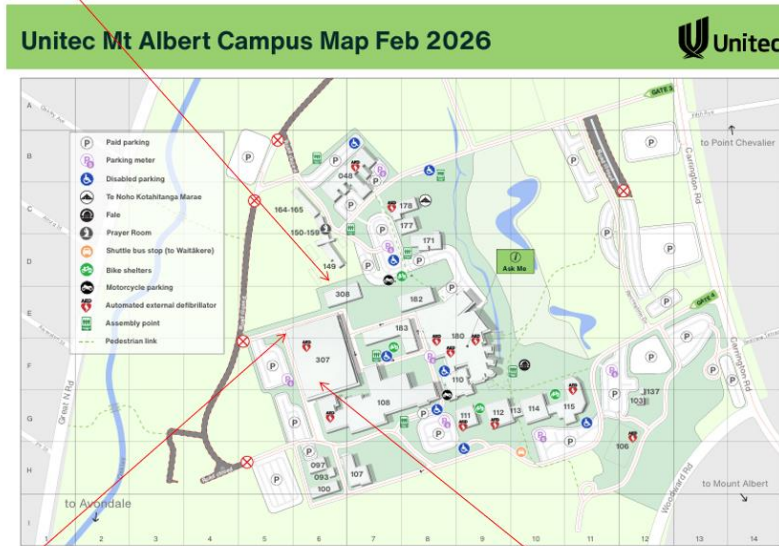
MIT students can connect to free Wi-Fi on campus

Firefighting training site

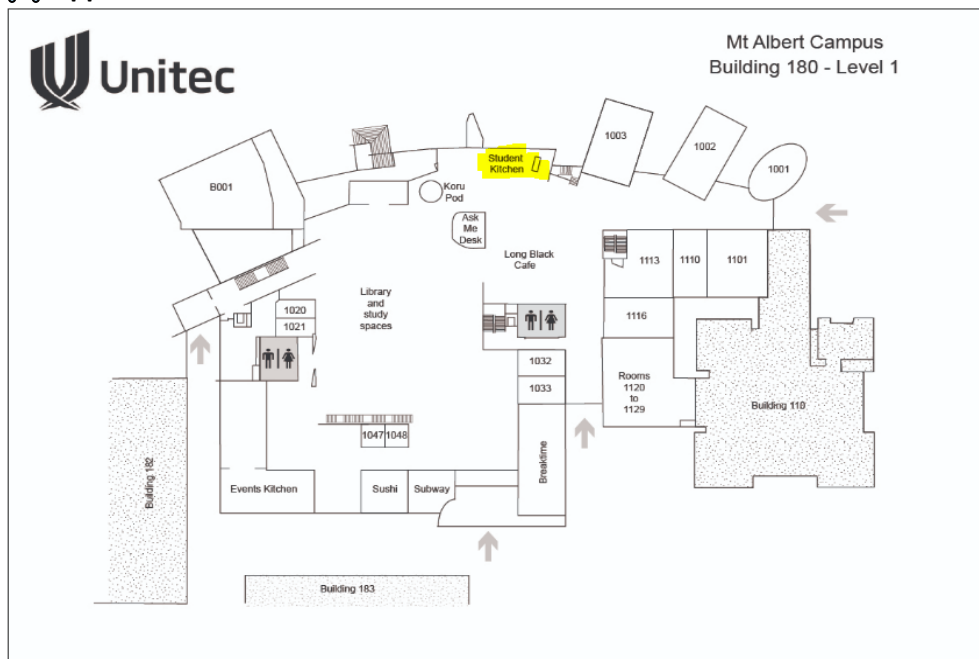
308-1001: Mahaika Marine Firefighting Training Site
