MIT values its international students and is committed to supporting them throughout their academic journey. As part of this commitment, we offer a number of international study grants each year. These grants are available to international students who are either new to MIT or progressing to a higher-level qualification at MIT, including Certificate, Diploma or Bachelor's programmes. To be eligible for the Early Bird Study Grant, you must apply for your programme before the relevant application deadline.

Feb intake: Wednesday, 18 November 2026 May intake: Monday, 01 February 2027 July intake: Monday, 26 April 2027 October intake: Friday, 6 August 2027

OUR COMMITMENT TO PASTORAL CARE



The safety and wellbeing of all our learners is important to us. We have a wide range of support systems, services and resources available to ensure our international students are cared for and supported during their time with us.

We're required by law to meet New Zealand's International and Domestic Pastoral Care Code, (the Code) which applies to all registered tertiary providers across the country. This is administered and monitored by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA).

An updated Code came into effect in January 2022 which mandates one set of clear rules and expectations for embedding safety and wellbeing into systems and day-to-day practices – tailored to learners' needs.

Here's a summary of the Code as it relates to international students.

Tertiary providers should ensure international students:

- are protected and supported from when they leave their home country, to when they finish their education journey
- are aware of their rights and protections
- feel safe and happy while studying in New Zealand
- are provided correct information through agents, who act professionally
- are aware of the terms and conditions of their enrolment.
